#### Organization Overview

JTCC is the premier tennis club in Washington, DC metropolitan area offering an exceptional 32-court tennis facility featuring indoor, outdoor, hard, red and green clay courts. JTCC offers a pathway for junior tennis players starting at any age to develop their interest in the sport to reach their full potential. Whether the child is introduced as a 3 year old in JTCC's Tennis Whizz programs or decides to pick up the game at a later stage, there are specific age appropriate programs for any child. JTCC also offers instructional, social and competitive programs for adults of all skill levels. From the "Rally in 10" class for beginner players to the "Adult Champs" advanced group, JTCC provides fun and challenging opportunities for everyone.

#### Position Details

We are looking to hire part-time coaches for our Red, Orange, Green Junior Programs as well as our Adult Programs. Our Junior Programs in the Fall, Winter and Spring Sessions are after school hours and weekends. Our Adult Programs are held in the evenings during the weekdays and morning and afternoon on the weekends.

#### Primary Responsibilities

- Personally teach on court and implement our Play based methodology at JTCC and satellite sites (Junior and Adults).
- Support staff for core weekend programming and weeknight Rally in 10 and Rally Now programming
- Teach tennis to children in our Community Outreach programs.
- Recommend transitions through our developmental pathways.
- Help Director of Tennis with nine week curriculum building.
- Monitor daily attendance.

#### Qualifications

- Have USPTA or PTR certification within six months of start of employment.
- Seeking a responsible person with experience working with children and adults.
- Must have tennis teaching experience.
- Must be professional, responsive and resourceful.
- Strong verbal communication skills are necessary.
- Must have strong leadership skills.
